My job was to Co-ordinate the councils response in an emergency. I was on call 24/7 for 1 week out of 6, and responded with an emergency response vehicle.

One incident involved a "suspect package" in a residential area. I responded along with other emergency services, to establish the location of the item, create a cordon, and evacuate houses in the vicinity. In most cases, a rest centre would need to be established, usually with any nearby council premises at our disposal.

Other incidents include, Bridge Strikes, House Fires, and Environmental issues. This role also Included Events Control and Management. This would involve the safety of the public and staff at major events, and creating contingency plans and risk assessments for likely incidents. Some of the events included the Swindon Half Marathon and Radio 1's Big Weekend
